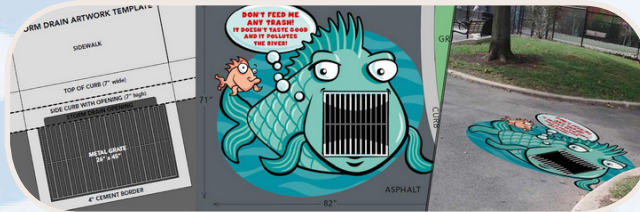

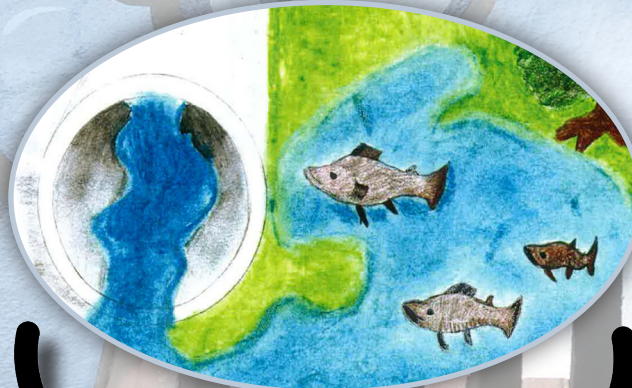
WINNERS

ONLY RAIN

DOWN THE DRAIN!

Did you know... when rain or melting snow flows over the land, it picks up pollutants, like trash, dog poop, oil from leaking cars, and carries it into our storm drains - which lead to the Schuylkill River.

Most of us within the Schuylkill watershed get our drinking water from the Schuylkill River. By keeping our storm drains clean, we're helping to keep our drinking water clean.



EVERY STREAM MATTERS

Small upstream waters are connected to larger downstream waterways, such as rivers, lakes, bays, and coastal waters. Protecting upstream waters is important for clean drinking water, farms, and healthy communities.
